WINEMAKER NOTES:

What started out looking like it was going to be the shortest growing season on record, turned out to be one of the longest. And worrisome drought conditions brought us a smaller yield, but beautifully concentrated, perfectly ripe fruit which resulted in sweet, delicious tannins and exceptional color. Estate grown at our sustainably farmed Persephone Vineyard in the northeast corner of the Napa Valley, the Syrah grapes were hand-picked and hand-sorted before spending 28 days macerating on their skins. 81% Syrah, 19% Cabernet Sauvignon.

SENSORY DESCRIPTION:

Dark garnet in color, the 2007 Syrah is sumptuous and focused, with intense aromas of huckleberry, cocoa, a hint of black pepper and baking spice. This one has a long and sexy finish that will call you back for more!
