WINEMAKER NOTES: The 2007 growing season was marked by a dry spring and early veraison (color change), which led us to believe 2007 would be a quick harvest, but cooling conditions in September and October turned it into one of the longest. Moderate yields were punctuated by smaller berries and a larger skin to pulp ratio resulting in sweet, delicious tannins and exceptional color in the reds. 100% Estate grown at our Persephone Ranch Vineyard located on the backside of Howell Mountain, where altitude and soil contribute to wines that are intense, layered and complex in flavor.

SENSORY DESCRIPTION: Bright ruby in color with hues of magenta and rose. The nose is loaded with cherry cola, classic briar berry fruit, and a hint of white pepper. The palate builds with brilliant notes of razzleberry pie (raspberry and blackberry), toasted macadamia nuts and a hint of cinnamon. This is an elegant wine with a lengthy finish, bright acidity and well-structured tannins. Drink now or age for 5-7 years.
