VINTAGE

Mendocino and Sonoma County's warm days, cool nights and pacific winds create ideal growing conditions for French Colombard. Late May saw the first blooming and gave us generous and rich grape clusters. As temperatures rose, summer's moderate heat stretched longer than expected allowing the grapes to achieve ideal ripeness and maximum flavor. Our 2017 wines are showcasing to be increasingly vibrant, lush and aromatic.

Entice your senses with our 2017 Carnivál. Bright, aromatic and fresh, this wine exhibits alluring aromas of dried apricot, orange blossom and white peach. The palate compliments the nose with flavors of pineapple, ripe Asian pear and a pop of naval orange zest.
