VINTAGE

Mendocino and Sonoma County's warm days, cool nights and pacific winds create ideal growing conditions for French Colombard. The 2018 north coast summer was cooler than the last 5 years with no prolonged heat spells. The cooler temperatures slowed down the ripening of the grapes and extended the growing season. Our 2018 wines are showcasing to be increasingly vibrant, lush and aromatic.

TASTING

The nose on our 2018 Carnivál is aromatically floral with alluring notes of fresh cut pear, dried apricot, candied lemon peel and nectarine. The palate compliments the nose with bright acidity and flavors of pineapple, ripe Asian pear and a pop of naval orange zest.
