VINEYARDS

We believe great wines are made in the vineyard and are committed to farming sustainably and naturally to preserve these properties for the long term. We are certified organic at our Rutherford vineyard. In 2019, all six of our estate vineyards were certified Fish Friendly Farming as part of our ongoing commitment to sustainability.

VINTAGE

The beginning of the 2019 growing season was defined by copious rainfall. The long, warm summer saw very few extreme heat events, with foggy mornings setting the stage for vibrant and expressive wines. The long, relatively mild finish to the season, not without its moments of unpredictability, helped to preserve freshness and finesse in the vit with abundant hang time teasing out great color, structure and soft tannins.

TASTING

Plentiful aromas of blackberry, plum, blackcurrant, and a hint of white mocha complement the wine's beautifully layered flavors of supple fruit and oak. Full-bodied with a rich texture and firm tannins, the wine lingers with a long, velvety finish. Hints of anise and bay leaf add complexity to the palate, further enhancing its depth and character. A Cabernet Sauvignon of this quality and depth is destined to evolve gracefully for years to come.
