VINEYARDS

We believe great wines are made in the vineyard and are committed to farming sustainably and naturally to preserve these properties for the long term. We are certified organic at our Rutherford vineyard. In 2019, all six of our estate vineyards were certified Fish Friendly Farming as part of our ongoing commitment to sustainability.

VINTAGE

The 2021 vintage will be remembered for low yields with intensely-flavored, small-sized berries, and a smooth harvest season. The season started off with very little rain, leading to the 2nd year of drought conditions in Napa Valley. The drought of 2021 resulted in a more natural load on the vines, requiring less pruning and dropping of fruit. The resulting grapes were packed full of flavor.

TASTING

Our 2021 Legacy Collection Merlot is a vibrant and complex wine. Fresh plum dances on the palate, accompanied by the subtle warmth of cedar and a hint of mint. Baking spice and nutmeg emerge, adding a layer of complexity that enhances the overall profile. Dark cherry and dried cranberry flavors contribute to the wine's dynamic character, creating a harmonious blend of fruity sweetness and subtle tartness. The soft tannins provide a smooth and elegant finish, rounding out this Merlot.
